
Satellite 5 Prize Crossword

- 24: The computer operating system on the ISS. It is a version of Linux (6)
- 26: Soviet space station whose name means "peace" (3)
- Where Soyuz and Progress rockets are launched from (8)
- 29: Combined Operational Load Bearing External Resistance Treadmill (7)
- The first soviet space station whose name means "salute" (6)
- 31: US module on the ISS, also known as Node 1 (5)
- 32: Means "search", and is the name one of the miniresearch modules on the ISS (5)
- 33: The other space station orbiting Earth (8)
- 34: Soviet military space project which used the Salyut2, 3 and 5 stations. The name means "Diamond" (5)

- 2: The airlock on the US side of the ISS (5)
- 3: One of the multi-purpose logistics modules (8)
- 4: The Soviet rocket system which currently transports astronauts to the ISS (5)
- 7: Space shuttle that brought Unity into space (9)
- 9: The shuttle that brought the Columbus laboratory module into space (8)
- 10: Means "hope", and is the Japanese laboratory module and the largest on the ISS (4)
- 13: First ISS module, which means "Sunrise" (5)
- 15: The other multi-purpose logistics module (9)
- 16: Unmanned testing platform owned by Bigelow Aerospace (7)
- 19: The European module of the ISS (8)
- 20: Means "science", and is a proposed future laboratory module (5)
- 21: The robotic manipulator (6)
- 22: Means "dawn", and is another mini-research module (7)
- 23: Means "pier" and is the docking module on the ISS (4)
- 25: Automated resupply craft (8)
- 27: Soviet rocket system which launched Soviet modules into space (6)
- 29: ESA observatory module on the ISS (6)
